Please contact us to enroll and send a copy of your meal-status eligibility letter. The \$25 registration fee, supply fees, and Extended Hour are not covered by financial aid. These fees are due with the registration form.

Classes run by outside vendors may not be eligible for financial aid.

Discounts/financial aid cannot be combined. One discount or financial aid per student per session.

PICK-UP & DISMISSAL

- If you need to pick up your child early, please notify 116Kids in advance. When you arrive, enter the school through the main entrance on E 33rd St, alert the security guard, and a staff member will bring your child to you. **No early pick-ups can be accommodated before 3:15pm or after 4:45pm.**
- Dismissal for 116Kids is at 5:00pm on E 33rd St, outside of the school's main entrance. Please wait for your child's class to assemble at their line spot and make eye contact with your child's instructor before retrieving your child at dismissal. Please be patient as we dismiss all children to their families.
- We offer Extended Hour, from 5:00–6:00pm, for an additional \$100 per 10-week session.
- <u>Dismissal time is strictly enforced.</u> Please avoid Late Fees by always picking up your child on time.
 - o We offer a 10-minute grace period for all regular dismissals from 5:00-5:10pm.
 - o After 5:10pm, students will join our Extended Hour and a \$15 drop-in fee will be charged.
 - o All Extended Hour students must be picked up and out of the building by 6:00pm.
 - o Between 6:01-6:15pm, a \$20 Late Fee will be charged.
 - o Between 6:16-6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$40.
 - o After 6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$50.
 - o Subsequent late pick-ups will result in expulsion from our program.

To ensure the safety of your child:

- Please make sure your child knows their after-school schedule.
- Please make sure that all 'Emergency Contact' and 'Authorizations for Pick Up' are up-to-date in your account. We do not have access to 'Blue Cards' kept on file with PS116, so you must update that information directly with 116Kids.
- Please be aware that we do not allow same-day enrollments. Please plan accordingly.

BEHAVIORAL POLICY

116Kids strives to maintain an environment where children feel safe. Please review these guidelines with your child so they may enjoy our after-school program. All children should:

- o show respect for others, their space and their property, as well as the space and property of the classrooms in which we hold our classes,
- o cooperate with 116Kids supervisors and instructors,
- o remain at their designated table during snack and while waiting for 116Kids instructors to take them to class, remain with their instructors during classes and until a parent/guardian signs them out at pick-up.

Unacceptable behaviors include: using profanity, disrespecting others and their space, failure to comply with directions, excessive horseplay, and inappropriate or violent physical contact. 116Kids may report incidents of unacceptable behavior to the parents/guardians of all children involved. If your child becomes disruptive or does something dangerous, it will result in a suspension of the child's next class. If the behavior continues, it could lead up to dismissal from 116Kids. 116Kids reserves the right to remove a child from the program for unacceptable behavior.

116Kids also strives to maintain an environment where staff feel safe. As such, we have required behavior and conduct for all members of our community. Threatening a staff member or undermining the policies of 116Kids is strictly prohibited and may result in permanent removal from any and all of our programs.

All other classes not labelled as "Double Features" are 2-hour single-focus classes.

MONDAYS

Space Camp Mini • Grades PreK-K • Isabel Renner & Madeleine Robinson

This class was created for our youngest students with activities timed to hold their attention and keep them engaged. Attention intergalactic explorers, buckle up and prepare to launch into a universe of fun! Every week, we'll explore a different aspect of space through read-alouds, crafts, and play. We'll build our own rockets, design planets, and create super cool jetpacks! Supply fee \$20.

Animals in Art • Grades K-2 • Chuck Connelly

Animals have been a source of inspiration for many artists, and a source of admiration for many children. Each week, we'll learn about a different artist's depiction of wildlife, then we will react via drawing, painting, and three-dimensional mediums.
