FINANCIAL AID

If your family meets the federal guidelines for free lunch, <u>we offer financial aid for tuition of one class per child per session</u>. Please contact us to enroll and send a copy of your meal-status eligibility letter. A \$25 registration fee is due with the registration form. Extended Hour is not covered by financial aid.

Classes run by outside vendors may not be eligible for financial aid.

Discounts/financial aid cannot be combined. One discount or financial aid per student per session.

PICK-UP & DISMISSAL

- If you need to pick up your child early, please notify 116Kids in advance. When you arrive, enter the school through the main entrance on E 33rd St, alert the security guard, and a staff member will bring your child to you. **No early pick-ups can be accommodated before 3:15pm or after 4:45pm.**
- Dismissal for 116Kids is at 5:00pm on E 33rd St, outside of the school's main entrance. Please wait for your child's class to assemble at their line spot and make eye contact with your child's instructor before retrieving your child at dismissal. Please be patient as we dismiss all children to their families.
- We offer Extended Hour, from 5:00–6:00pm, for an additional \$10/day, paid on a full semester basis.
- <u>Dismissal time is strictly enforced.</u> Please avoid Late Fees by always picking up your child on time.
 - We offer a 10-minute grace period for all regular dismissals from 5:00-5:10pm.
 - o After 5:10pm, students will join our Extended Hour and a \$15 drop-in fee will be charged.
 - o All Extended Hour students must be picked up and out of the building by 6:00pm.
 - o Between 6:01-6:15pm, a \$20 Late Fee will be charged.
 - o Between 6:16-6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$40.
 - o After 6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$50.
 - o Subsequent late pick-ups will result in expulsion from our program.

To ensure the safety of your child:

- Please make sure that all 'Emergency Contact' and 'Authorizations for Pick Up' are up-to-date in your account. We
 do not have access to 'Blue Cards' kept on file with PS116, so you must update that information directly with
 116Kids.
- YOU MUST NOTIFY US IF YOUR CHILD HAS ANY ALLERGIES OR DIETARY RESTRICTIONS.
- Please be aware that we do not allow same-day enrollments. Please plan accordingly.

BEHAVIORAL POLICY

116Kids strives to maintain an environment where children feel safe. Please review these guidelines with your child so they may enjoy our after-school program. All children should:

- o show respect for others, their space and their property, as well as the space and property of the classrooms in which we hold our classes,
- cooperate with 116Kids supervisors and instructors,
- o remain at their designated table during snack and while waiting for 116Kids instructors to take them to class, remain with their instructors during classes and until a parent/guardian signs them out at pick-up.

116Kids reserves the right to remove a child from the program for unacceptable behavior. Unacceptable behaviors include: inappropriate or violent physical contact, elopement, disrespecting others and their space, excessive horseplay, failure to comply with directions, and using profanity. 116Kids may report incidents of unacceptable behavior to the parents/guardians of all children involved. If your child becomes disruptive or does something dangerous, it will result in a suspension of the child's next class. If the behavior continues, it could lead up to dismissal from 116Kids for one or more semesters.

116Kids also strives to maintain an environment where staff feel safe. As such, we have required behavior and conduct for all members of our community. Threatening a staff member or undermining the policies of 116Kids is strictly prohibited and may result in permanent removal from any and all of our programs.

MONDAYS Total cost \$280

AquaNUTS • Grades K-2 • Mitzy Jimenez

Are you a sucker for sharks, wacky for whales and passionate about penguins? Then you just might be an AquaNUT! Put on your flippers and get ready to make a splash exploring aquatic creatures. We'll create our own tide pools, make beautiful rainbow fish, and have fun with some very chompy sharks. It's going to be fin-tastic!
