# PICK-UP & DISMISSAL

- If you need to pick up your child early, please notify 116Kids in advance. When you arrive, enter the school through the main entrance on E 33<sup>rd</sup> St, alert the security guard, and a staff member will bring your child to you. **No early pick-ups can be accommodated before 3:15pm or after 4:45pm.**
- Dismissal for 116Kids is at 5:00pm on E 33<sup>rd</sup> St, outside of the school's main entrance. **Please wait for your child's class to assemble at their line spot and make eye contact with your child's instructor before retrieving your child at dismissal. Please be patient as we dismiss all children to their families.**
- We offer Extended Hour, from 5:00–6:00pm, for an additional \$10/day, paid on a full semester basis.
- **Dismissal time is strictly enforced. Please avoid Late Fees by always picking up your child on time.**
  - We offer a 10-minute grace period for all regular dismissals from 5:00-5:10pm.
  - After 5:10pm, students will join our Extended Hour and a \$15 drop-in fee will be charged.
  - **All Extended Hour students must be picked up and out of the building by 6:00pm.**
  - Between 6:01-6:15pm, a \$20 Late Fee will be charged.
  - Between 6:16-6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$40.
  - After 6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$50.
  - Subsequent late pick-ups will result in expulsion from our program.

## To ensure the safety of your child:

- Please make sure that all 'Emergency Contact' and 'Authorizations for Pick Up' are up-to-date in your account. **We do not have access to 'Blue Cards' kept on file with PS116, so you must update that information directly with 116Kids.**
- **YOU MUST NOTIFY US IF YOUR CHILD HAS ANY ALLERGIES OR DIETARY RESTRICTIONS.**
- Please be aware that we do not allow same-day enrollments. Please plan accordingly.

### ***BEHAVIORAL POLICY***

116Kids strives to maintain an environment where children feel safe. Please review these guidelines with your child so they may enjoy our after-school program. All children should:

- show respect for others, their space and their property, as well as the space and property of the classrooms in which we hold our classes,
- cooperate with 116Kids supervisors and instructors,
- remain at their designated table during snack and while waiting for 116Kids instructors to take them to class, remain with their instructors during classes and until a parent/guardian signs them out at pick-up.

116Kids reserves the right to remove a child from the program for unacceptable behavior. Unacceptable behaviors include: inappropriate or violent physical contact, elopement, disrespecting others and their space, excessive horseplay, failure to comply with directions, and using profanity. 116Kids may report incidents of unacceptable behavior to the parents/guardians of all children involved. If your child becomes disruptive or does something dangerous, it will result in a suspension of the child's next class. If the behavior continues, it could lead up to dismissal from 116Kids for one or more semesters.

116Kids also strives to maintain an environment where staff feel safe. As such, we have required behavior and conduct for all members of our community. Threatening a staff member or undermining the policies of 116Kids is strictly prohibited and may result in permanent removal from any and all of our programs.

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**MONDAYS****Total cost \$520****Color Theory 101 • Grades K-2 • Chuck Connelly**

In this fun art class, we will learn the basics of color theory like how colors interact with each other and how they can be combined. We will answer questions like what are opposing colors, what are warm and cool colors, are black and white colors? We'll use a variety of medium to paint, sculpt, and draw original works each week.

**Lego Robotics/Art & Chill Jr • Grades K-2 • Mark Melman/Gokul Venkatachalam**

In this **DOUBLE FEATURE** class, we'll learn the basics of programming and hone our problem-solving skills using Lego Mindstorm EV3 kits. In this immersive language class, we'll learn introductory Spanish through games, songs, and crafts. New & returning students welcome. Next, playtime abounds! We'll play outside, we'll play inside. We'll play yard games, circle games, and card games. We'll play with our enviable collection of Legos and Playmobil.

**Science Around Us • Grades K-2 • Liza LaTurno**
