TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILD:

- You must notify us if your child has any allergies or dietary restrictions. We do not have access to any information shared with the school nurse or other PS116 professionals.
- Please make sure that all 'Emergency Contact' & 'Authorizations for Pick Up' are up-to-date in your 116Kids account. We do not have access to 'Blue Cards.'
- Please be aware that we do not allow same-day enrollments. Please plan accordingly.

PICK-UP & DISMISSAL:

- No early pick-ups can be accommodated before 3:15pm or after 4:45pm.
- Dismissal for 116Kids is at 5:00pm on E 33rd St, outside of the school's main entrance. Please wait for your child's class to assemble at their line spot and make eye contact with your child's instructor before retrieving your child at dismissal. Please be patient as we dismiss all children to their families.
- We offer Extended Hour, from 5:00–6:00pm, for an additional \$12.50/day, paid on a full semester basis.
- <u>Dismissal time is strictly enforced.</u> Please avoid Late Fees by always picking up your child on time.
 - o We offer a 10-minute grace period for all regular dismissals from 5:00-5:10pm.
 - o After **5:10pm**, students will join our Extended Hour and a \$15 drop-in fee will be charged.
 - o All Extended Hour students must be picked up and out of the building by 6:00pm.
 - o Between 6:01-6:15pm, a \$20 Late Fee will be charged.
 - o Between 6:16-6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$40.
 - o After 6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$50.
 - o Subsequent late pick-ups will result in expulsion from our program.

REGISTRATION TIPS: (SAVE TIME WHEN REGISTERING BY READING THIS NOW!!)

- Please pay special attention to the grade groupings and register only for the classes for which your child is eligible. If you receive the error message "this student doesn't meet the grade requirement for one or more classes," confirm that your information is correct then click 'Checkout' to bypass that message. It will NOT stop you from enrolling.
- While most of our classes are a balance between active, outdoor activities and enriching arts or STEM-based projects, some classes focus solely on more in-depth classroom-based activities. These classes DO NOT schedule any time for free-play in our yard or gym and are labelled with * on the following pages. If your child is looking for more active play, please consider enrolling in one of our other classes.
- **Some classes sell out in <u>seconds</u>.** This is not a glitch. Those classes are very popular and most of our families enroll exactly at 12pm. <u>Please have a 2nd choice class selected</u>.
- Hi-Five Sports is a separate program, not affiliated with 116Kids. Online registration and payments for this class

MONDAYS

Meet the Artists: NYC* • Grades K-2 • Chuck Connelly

Basquiat, de Kooning, Carmen Herrera, Helen Frankenthaler ... the list goes on. We'll examine works by these, and other, famous artists who got their start right here in NYC. Students will explore how each artist's unique style and story can inspire their own creative voice as they create works of their own. We'll use a variety of mediums to paint, sculpt, and draw masterpieces to rival the originals.

Musical Building Blocks: Beats & Melodies* • Grades K-2 • Jimmy Stull/Holland Wyatt

In this dynamic music class, students will explore the fundamentals of percussion and keyboards. They'll break down songs to understand rhythmic structure, create their own instruments, and use body percussion to make beats. Students will also learn how to tell melodic stories by studying keyboard basics. Through a mix of individual and group work, students will practice essential techniques such as finger placement, chord progressions, scales, and key recognition. Students will gain the tools they'll need to become the next generation of composers.

Cardboard Kingdom* • Grades 3-5 • Roxanne Warrick

Welcome to the Cardboard Kingdom, where your wildest ideas come to life with just cardboard and your limitless creativity! Let's transform simple boxes into castles, rockets, and even fantastical creatures!
