MONDAY

K-2nd

Music Makers (NEW!)

If your child likes to sing, dance, play an instrument, or just loves to listen to music, this is the class for them! Great for kids who crave structure and active free play - yard time every day, weather permitting.

Hi-Five

If your child is sporty, this is a no-brainer. High-energy, structured, and active. Classes are held in the gym, so the fun continues no matter the weather.

3rd-5th

Creative Portrait Studio (NEW!)

Part photography, part set-building (think Old West fairground portraits). Perfect for kids who love diving into a detailed project across the whole session. Minimal outdoor time, but Ms. Roxanne builds in indoor free play (Legos, board games). Not ideal for students who need active/yard time.

World Building

A beloved legacy class created by the students. They design their own world - laws, alliances, and conflicts. Lots of outdoor active play when weather allows. This was our most-requested class this semester and will likely sell out quickly.

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TUESDAY

K-2nd

Challenge Champs

For kids who thrive on structure. Students invent games (including active games), but it remains an arts-based class with focused project work and little-to-no active yard play.

Karaoke & Kahoot (NEW!)

For kids who want a bit of both worlds - play + performance. Our students requested a Kahoot class, and Ms. Cherry is pairing it with an energetic karaoke session.

Watercolor Workshop

Perfect for our artists. Mr. Chuck creates an inspiring environment and develops engaging lessons featuring new artists and techniques each week. This class does not schedule free time or play in the yard.

3rd-5th

Culinary Adventures (NEW!)

Students research and test no-cook recipes and collaborate to create a cookbook. Our most-requested topic this semester (students wanted FOOD!), and likely to sell out fast.

Hi-Five

A great sports alternative if Culinary Adventures fills up before you enroll.

WEDNESDAY

K-2nd

Imagination Station

Enriching downtime with Mr. Jon's read-alouds. Collaborative playtime with friends and access to our amazing cache of toys . Active free play (weather permitting). Crowd pleaser for all types of children.

Science Around Us

Ms Liza leads our most popular class. Projects take the full two hours — no outdoor time or free play. If your child needs movement/active play, please consider a different class. This class sells out in seconds. Literally. It's sold out before 12:01.

Sculpture

Great for art lovers and everyone else :) Featuring different forms of clay and moldable materials, sensory seekers will thrive. Mr. Jimmy makes sure the kids get their bodies moving (weather permitting) every day.

Editing (NEW!)

Popular request from our older students. Ms. Tatiana really went to bat to make it happen for them. Students learn beginner video-editing skills on individual Chromebooks. Ms Tatiana always builds in active play time in the yard, weather permitting.

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Game On

Student-driven active play with coaching, structure, and lots of movement. This class has dibs on the gym, so the fun will continue no matter the weather.

Rainbows, Diamonds, & More

A creative, elevated jewelry class. Extremely detailed projects with our incredible bead collection. No yard time; best for kids who enjoy focused art.

Bead Magic

Access to our out-of-this-world bead stash. Ms Izzy always includes active play, giving this class a nice arts-and-movement balance.

Paint Time

A perennial favorite that consistently sells out because everyone loves Mr Jon!

Sports & Spotlight (NEW!)

One hour of gym sports + one hour of theater games and improv. A great fit for kids who like to move and perform. One hour of access to the gym, so the active play continues no matter the weather.

116News: Sports Media (NEW!)

One hour of gym sports + one hour learning the basics of sports media. A great new hybrid class.

Surprise Studio (NEW!)

Perfect for artists and builders. Not a match for kids who need outdoor, active play.

Student demand for food classes was sky-high! Big, exciting projects — but not ideal for kids who need outdoor free-play time.

Perfect for children who want to end the week with active play.
