



## Spring Session Cheat Sheet

Need more info to help you decide on the best class for your child? Here's my insider scoop.

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### MONDAY

#### K-2nd

##### **Music Makers 2.0 (UPDATED!)**

I shouldn't pick favorites ... so let's just say this class impresses me every week. Ms Izzy plans dynamic lessons that get the kids engaged and moving. This semester, she is adding crafts! Students will make their own instruments. Great for kids who crave structure *and* active free play - yard time every day, weather permitting.

##### **Hi-Five**

If your child is sporty, this is a no-brainer. High-energy, structured, and active. Classes are held in the gym, so the fun continues no matter the weather.

#### 3rd-5th

##### **2D World (NEW!)**

This class was inspired by the beautiful artwork of two of our students (thanks Ruth and Mayline!). Students will create their own books with moving pieces and interactive elements. Creative kids, book lovers, artists will love this class.

##### **International Food Critics (NEW!)**

Snackers rejoice! Kids who love food and talking about the things they've tried will thrive in this class. It'll feature snacks from around the world and Ms Tatiana will guide the kids on how to create engaging and "click-worthy" vlogs reviewing the foods.

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## TUESDAY

### K-2nd

#### **Arts & Crafts**

This class was a huge hit last Spring. It features active play, crafts, imagination, and silly quests that will keep our playful kids happy. Plus, I convinced Ms Jannah to leave preK for an afternoon and join our K-5 team, and the students will love her patient, caring, and nurturing personality.

#### **Make it Mini: Munchies (NEW!)**

Crafts + food – what could be better? Make it Mini is a long-running offering of Ms Roxanne's and this edition is extra special because it features REAL FOOD for some of the projects. This class does not feature much outdoor time, so is not the best fit for students looking for free play in the yard.

#### **Meet the Artists: Abstraction**

Don't let the lofty terms in this class description hold you back. Mr Chuck introduces the students to artists and artistic movements in accessible ways and he allows them the freedom to truly express themselves as artists. This approach supports the "process over product" approach to art, which is a foundational philosophy of 116Kids.

### 3rd-5th

#### **YouTube University**

Our students ask for this class every semester! They get to create their own "YouTube-style" vlogs on any topic that interests them (we do NOT post anything online– that is done at families' own discretion).

#### **Hi-Five**

A great sports alternative if YouTube University fills up before you enroll.

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## WEDNESDAY

### K-2nd

#### **Cooking Crafts**

This class combines three things our students love – food, crafts, and Ms Michelle! She is back for Spring 2026. Students in this class will create edible food art each week, and will have plenty of time for free play in the yard as well.

#### **Paint Time**

A perennial favorite that consistently sells out because everyone loves Mr Jon!

#### **Science Around Us**

Ms Liza leads our most popular class. Projects take the full two hours — no outdoor time or free play. If your child needs movement/active play, please consider a different class. This class sells out in seconds. Literally. It's sold out before 12:01.

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### 3rd–5th

#### **Dungeons & Dragons (NEW!)**

The students BEGGED Ms Tatiana to offer this class! A great fit for learners or experienced players ... or just anyone who loves Ms Tatiana's classes. She makes every afternoon special.

#### **Make it Mini: Gnome Edition (NEW!)**

Anyone who joined us for remote classes during the pandemic (remember those?!) might remember the amazing “tree houses” that Ms Roxanne made with the students. We're taking that project even further in this full semester class. Great for crafters, artists, imaginative/creative students.

#### **Yard Games Sr**

Mr Jimmy is back with our older students this semester to offer a perennial favorite. The students guide the sports we will feature, and Mr Jimmy is there to scaffold, support, and emphasize sportsmanship in this low-pressure, high-energy class.

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## THURSDAY

### K–2nd

#### **Junk Journaling**

Students can unwind and express themselves in this creative class. Ms Izzy always includes active play, giving this class a nice arts-and-movement balance.

#### **World Travelers**

Ms Cherry packs this class full of crafts, music, food, and culture. I can't think of a single student in our program who would not LOVE this class.

#### **Yard Games Jr**

Just like the version for our older students, this class is low-pressure and high-energy. Mr Jimmy will lead fun games in the yard like kickball, basketball, relay races, etc.

### 3rd–5th

#### **Movie Making**

Movie Making is back for another semester of creativity! Ms Tatiana supports the students wacky and wonderfully imaginative ideas and skillfully guides them into creating something special your whole family will enjoy.

#### **We've Got Game**

One of Ms Roxanne's most popular classes, here students will make their own games each week. A great fit for any gamers or creative students.

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## FRIDAY

### K–2nd

#### **Hi-Five**

Perfect for children who want to end the week with active play.

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## K-5th

### **Witches & Wizards**

This special class is for any students in K-5<sup>th</sup> grade, so it is a great fit for any of our students with friends in older or younger grade groupings. It is also great for magic lovers, crafty kids, and gamers.
