# PICK-UP & DISMISSAL

- If you need to pick up your child early, please notify 116Kids in advance. When you arrive, enter the school through the main entrance on E 33<sup>rd</sup> St, alert the security guard, and a staff member will bring your child to you. **No early pick-ups can be accommodated before 3:15pm or after 4:45pm.**
- Dismissal for 116Kids is at 5:00pm on E 33<sup>rd</sup> St, outside of the school's main entrance.
- We offer Extended Hour, from 5:00–6:00pm, for an additional \$100 per 10-week session.
- **Dismissal time is strictly enforced. Please avoid Late Fees by always picking up your child on time.**
  - We offer a 10-minute grace period for all regular dismissals from 5:00-5:10pm.
  - After 5:10pm, students will join our Extended Hour and a \$15 drop-in fee will be charged.
  - **All Extended Hour students must be picked up and out of the building by 6:00pm.**
  - Between 6:01-6:15pm, a \$20 Late Fee will be charged.
  - Between 6:16-6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$40.
  - After 6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$50.
  - Subsequent late pick-ups will result in expulsion from our program.

## ***BEHAVIORAL POLICY***

**116Kids strives to maintain an environment where children feel safe.** Please review these guidelines with your child so they may enjoy our after-school program. All children should:

- show respect for others, their space and their property, as well as the space and property of the classrooms in which we hold our classes,
- cooperate with 116Kids supervisors and instructors,
- remain at their designated table during snack and while waiting for 116Kids instructors to take them to class, remain with their instructors during classes and until a parent/guardian signs them out at pick-up.

Unacceptable behaviors include: using profanity, disrespecting others and their space, failure to comply with directions, excessive horseplay, and inappropriate or violent physical contact. 116Kids may report incidents of unacceptable behavior to the parents/guardians of all children involved. If your child becomes disruptive or does something dangerous, it will result in a suspension of the child's next class. If the behavior continues, it could lead up to dismissal from 116Kids. 116Kids reserves the right to remove a child from the program for unacceptable behavior.

**116Kids also strives to maintain an environment where staff feel safe.** As such, we have required behavior and conduct for all members of our community. Threatening a staff member or undermining the policies of 116Kids is strictly prohibited and may result in permanent removal from any and all of our programs.

To ensure the safety of your child:

- Please make sure your child knows their after-school schedule.
- Please make sure that all 'Emergency Contact' and 'Authorizations for Pick Up' are up-to-date in your account. We do not have access to 'Blue Cards' kept on file with PS116, so you must update that information directly with 116Kids.
- **Please be aware that we do not allow same-day enrollments. Please plan accordingly.**
- Please make eye contact with your child's instructor before retrieving them at dismissal. Please be patient as we dismiss all children to their families.

# Please read to avoid confusion:

- All Winter Session classes will run for 2 hours and **you will only enroll in one class per afternoon**. Our "Double Feature" classes will allow students to participate in two distinct one-hour classes each afternoon, with the ease for parents of only enrolling in one class. All other classes not labelled as "Double Features" are 2-hour single-focus classes.
- To offset the tuition cost increase to parents for this year only, the PTA of PS116 has generously voted to apply 116Kids Reserve Funds to **cover all supply costs for the full 2022-2023 school year**. These fees are listed below but will not be charged at registration time.
- We are testing out some new grade groupings this session with classes created for our specific students and the friendships and shared interests we see among them. **Please pay special attention to the grade groupings and register only for the classes for which your child is eligible.**

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## MONDAYS

### **Sea, Land, Air • Grades PreK-K • Madeleine Robinson & Isabel Renner**

This class was created for our youngest students with activities timed to hold their attention and keep them engaged. Each week students will be introduced to a new animal from sea, land, or air. They'll learn about their life cycle, habitat, and diet. Next, they will have fun creating an art piece based on the animal. They will also get a visit from our Super Sports instructors for 30 minutes of movement and sports every week. Supply fee \$15.

### **Outside | In • Grades K-2 • Chuck Connelly**

While the weather brings us indoors this Winter, we'll travel outdoors through art! Each week, we will learn about a different outdoor art exhibit, then we will react via drawing, painting, and three-dimensional mediums. Artists studied will include Louise Nevelson, Pablo Picasso, Louise Bourgeois, and Jean Dubuffet. Supply fee \$20.

### **Super Sports • Grades 1-3 • Josh Wyatt & Jon Wyatt**

Calling all sports fanatics! If you've always got sports on the brain, then join us for an afternoon made for you. Kickball, dodge ball, soccer, basketball – we'll try them all. We'll round the afternoon out with 30 minutes of cool down via mindfulness activities.

### **Art & Chill Sr • Grades 3-5 • Roxanne Warrick**

Each student will have their own role/responsibility in every film we create, from director to editor to actor. Depending on the students' choice, we will either make many short films or work on one longer film throughout the class.
